

Leading universities of Belarus and India sign memorandums of cooperation

MINSK, 3 June (BelTA) - Leading universities of Belarus and India have signed memoranda of cooperation, BelTA has learned.

The Indira Gandhi National Tribal University has signed memorandums with the Belarusian State University of Informatics and Radioelectronics, the Belarusian State University of Physical Education and Sports, the Belarusian State University of Culture and Arts.
